

Financial Support - CAD\$300,000 Bursary for Hong Kong Students

A full bursary which covers your full tuition at McGill, your air tickets between Hong Kong and Canada, your book fees and miscellaneous expenses at McGill, your living expenses in Montreal, plus more.

McGill University, a top-ranking university in Canada, has recently launched a super bursary to help impoverished students from Hong Kong to fulfill their dreams towards overseas education.

Valued at CAD\$300,000 (more than HK\$1,800,000), the renewable bursary aims to provide essential financial support for one or more Hong Kong students from humble family backgrounds who aspire to study overseas. The winner(s)' tuition fee from commencement until graduation, health insurance, living expenses, textbooks and stationery, as well as international travels etc. may all be covered under this program.

The Gardner Hall Hong Kong Alumni Bursary

Established in 2017 by former Gardner Hall residents and McGill University alumni from Hong Kong, for one or more full-time undergraduate students born and residing in Hong Kong entering in any faculty at McGill University. The value of the Bursary is variable and may cover up to the cost of tuition and mandatory fees, a standard allowance for books and living costs, and a return trip home. Awarded by the Scholarships and Student Aid Office on the basis of high academic standing and demonstrated financial need. May be renewable provided good academic standing is maintained. Should a recipient of the Bursary not be renewed, in-course students may be considered.

Criteria**

You MUST

- ✓ Be Hong Kong-born
- ✓ Be academically strong
- ✓ Be able to secure admission to McGill
- ✓ You must choose McGill as your university of choice
- ✓ You must be able to prove that you need financial support
- ✓ Be residing in Hong Kong prior to your commencement of study at McGill

** Note: The award is both need and merit-based and your admission to McGill does not guarantee you the award. The CAD\$300,000 sum might be shared among one or more deserving students. The selection criteria are defined by the alumni donors concerned.
