Admissions

- Through HKU:
 - o IB does not include bonus points
 - o 3 HL and 3 SL, score of 19 at HL (Chinese A preferred)
 - No early admissions/ Fast Track option
 - o Math 1/2 won't count as part of core
 - Will do interview if personal consideration and deemed necessary (non-JUPAS will most likely be interviewed)
 - o double check later for HKU if they require LNAT
 - HKU will automatically consider you for local regular LLB program if you do not make into dual program (same course code)
 - HKU scholarships available if applied through HKU; Swire scholarships + government scholarships
 - o 90-100 applications last year
- UCL entry:
 - o LNAT required; entry essay mandatory
 - o 39/45 for UCL, prefer traditional subjects, HK alumni 12000 pounds
 - No interview for UCL
- Cannot apply to BOTH (will completely disqualify application) but can apply for dual through HKU and then do UCL 3 year

<u>Program</u>

- 2 LLB degrees
- Qualifies for PCLL in HK or PC in London
- Same thing as 3 year UCL and 4 year HKU law programs
- All students to start in UK and then come to HK in year 3
- UCL taught in small groups (8 person per class maximum); encourages extracurriculars, give own opinion, point of view
- Placement at Centre of Access to Justice (mandatory), opportunity to speak at tribunals, experiential learning, clinical education arm of UCL; provides opportunity to apply classroom knowledge,
- More attractive to international law firms
